

Removal of the Pure Michigan Byway Designation on M-37 North of US-31

COMMENT FORM

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is requesting public input regarding the planned removal of the Pure Michigan Byway designation on M-37 on Old Mission Peninsula. The removal is necessitated by the anticipated jurisdictional transfer of M-37 to the Grand Traverse County Road Commission for the portion of the highway within Peninsula Township and for the portion of M-37 north of US-31 within the Traverse City city limits.

The hearing and a 30-day public comment period are required due to the transfer resulting in the roadway becoming a city street and county road; only state highways can be designated under the program.
